Going to Tasmania again brings back fond memories of when we first went there in 2012. Besides seeing spectacular scenery, I have a vivid memory of walking through a very crowded Salamanca market in Hobart and being impacted by a painting. The painting was at the back of a marguee. I could see from a distance that there was a solitary cross on a hill. As I came closer, I could make out ten people before the cross from various walks of life. The thing that hit me though was the words at the bottom of the painting "Equal at the foot of the cross; equally in need of mercy", and the words on the cross: on the horizontal beam "mercy", and on the vertical beam "forgiveness".

The painting touched my heart and expressed everything I hold to. We are no better than anyone else. We've all done wrong and need God's mercy and forgiveness. Through the cross, through Jesus' sacrifice, dying in our place and bearing the punishment of our sins, we can receive mercy and forgiveness. Mission Murmuring:

The Leprosy Mission is celebrating 150 years of tending the world's poorest, with this oldest of all diseases. Leprosy caused by a bacteria, spread through coughing and sneezing attacks and destroys nerves in the body, especially, hands, feet, face, with loss of feeling and function. Someone is diagnosed every two minutes, with India accounting for 50% of all new cases each year. Huge discoveries over the years have changed treatments and care, and although the stigma does remain, in-roads have made leaps and bounds in finding a cure for this soul-destroying disease. With a course of the multi drug therapy, MDT, usually over a year, a person with leprosy can be cured. Leprosy can be made a thing of the past—the only problem is lack of funding and finance, to reach into all the world area, to provide this amazing life-transforming drug.
