Church Safe Policy for Basso Church

As a church, Basso has in place Church Safe Polices and Procedures, seeking to make all of our ministries and events safe places to be.

The main points of the Church Safe policy can be broken into three areas—Safe Ministries, Safe Environment, Safe People.

As part of that commitment, we have a number of measures in place, which we want to let you know about.

Screening Checks for Kids Ministries

We have screening checks for all staff and volunteers involved in kids ministries, including creche, Sunday Schools, Youth Groups and Kids Clubs. These checks include: Volunteer Application Forms, Working With Children checks, attending Church Safe Training and signing a Code of Conduct.

Safe Ministry Representatives

We have established a male and female "Safe Ministry Representative" at Basso. These Safe Ministry Representatives provide a contact point, where people at church know who they can go to, to make a complaint, report an incident, or seek information about any safe-ministry matters.

This is specifically for incidents or concerns regarding abuse or suspected abuse.

On our Notice boards at church, we have an infographic to show how to report any Child Safety Concerns, or any matters of concern that you may have for people's wellbeing. If you were to have some information, a concern of abuse, heard something and thought - "What do I do with this information?" - you have two designated people you can go to, in our Safe Ministry Representatives. Just as critical as it is to tell someone, it is as equally critical to NOT tell others who are not involved, so we don't do damage through gossip.
